## European Open Science Cloud and the EOSC-Pillar Project

The European Commission is investing resources in a new approach to Computing and Data infrastructures [1] that should overcome the current fragmentation. European Open Science Cloud [2] is conceived as a federation of existing infrastructures where the Member States will provide most of the resources and EC will support the process and provide the necessary funding for the "glue".

Pillar has been proposed and accepted. It will start on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019 for a 36 months duration and will address most of the key points in the EOSC process.
